The slim, comfortable neck has a modern easy-playing profile and joins the body at the 14th fret.

The fingerboard and bridge are rosewood, and the rosewood peghead overlay features the distinctive Durango logo in pearl and burned wooden western script – a feature not found on any other guitar! The top is X-braced and features a lovely herringbone soundhole rosette. Butterbean style tuners enhance the vintage look of these marvelous guitars.

Other models in the Durango line include the DF-350, with spruce top, the DF-355 with solid spruce top, the DF-360 with rosewood back & sides, and the top of-the-line DF-365 with rosewood back, sides and solid spruce top.
